

Congressman Mike Pence appeared on [NPR 's "Morning Edition"](#) to discuss President Obama's stimulus package:

*PENCE: I think most Hoosiers understand that we can't borrow and spend and bail our way back to a growing economy. A week ago, I was at a town hall meeting in Muncie, Indiana, and a woman stood up, told me with some tears in her eyes that she'd lost her job.
