

Congressman Pence was quoted in a *WTHR* story about Indiana's policymakers and their views on the auto bailout.

*Representative Mike Pence, who voted against the bailout plan that already passed out of the House, said the proposed bailout plan is fundamentally flawed because it does not allow for court sanctioned reorganization.*

*"What this industry needs is the legal ability to reorganize and their tens of billions of dollars to put that new plan into effect," Pence said. "Our belief is, we can do that through the federal courts and we can do that without burdening taxpayers."*

*If the big three should end up in the federal bankruptcy court, according to Congressman Pence, those suppliers which are so important here in Indiana, would be made whole.*
