

[Senator John McCain](#) , speaking to representatives of AP newspaper and broadcast members at their [annual meeting](#) , today [expressed "narrow support"](#) for the [Free Flow of Information Act](#) , of which Congressman Mike Pence is an author.

*"Thus, despite concerns I have about the legislation, I have narrowly decided to support it," McCain said. "I respect those of my colleagues who have decided not to, appreciate very much the concerns that have informed their position, and encourage further negotiations to address those concerns.
