

The *Indianapolis Star* [editorialized today](#) in favor of a new Social Security reform proposal that would end Congress' practice of using Social Security taxes to fund other federal spending.

Instead, under the plan crafted by Congressmen Paul Ryan (R-Wisc.), Sam Johnson (R-Texas), Jim McCrery (R-La.), John Shadegg (R-Ariz.) and Clay Shaw (R-Fla.), surplus revenue from Social Security taxes would be used to fund personal retirement accounts for workers who choose to enroll in the program.
