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Health reform could cost Indiana \$3.5B

The federal health-care legislation could cost Indiana as much as \$3.5 billion over the next 10 years, according to an analysis presented Wednesday to the State Budget Committee.

That estimate is up from a \$2.3 billion projection made in December before Congress passed the landmark legislation.

Robert Damler, a state-hired actuary, told lawmakers that the \$3.5 billion cost represents the total liability the state could face in additional expenses under the law from 2011 through 2020.

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
