

Economic Injury Disaster loans are available for all small businesses who suffered some type of economic loss due to the deadly storms that affected Indiana early March. **The deadline to apply is June 12**

Small businesses and most private nonprofit organizations in the following counties are eligible to apply for these low-interest loans from the Small Business Administration: Bartholomew, Brown, Decatur, Franklin, Gibson, Greene, Jackson, Jennings, Knox, Lawrence, Monroe, Morgan, Owen, Pike, Posey, Ripley, Rush, Shelby, Warrick and Vanderburgh counties in Indiana; Gallatin, Wabash and White in Illinois; and Henderson and Union in Kentucky.
