PENCE STATEMENT ON SAUDI ARABIA TERRORIST ATTACK

Washington, May 13, 2003 - WASHINGTON, DC – U.S. Congressman Mike Pence released the following statement today on the terrorist bombings in Saudi Arabia:

“My deepest sympathy goes out to the families of the victims killed in this attack. Terrorism is a threat to everyone--not only were there Americans and Saudis killed, but Jordanians, Filipinos, Lebanese and Swiss.

“As the President told thousands in Indiana today, the war on terror goes on and we will not relent until every American and every freedom loving person can live free of the fear of terrorist violence.

“I will do everything I can to give President Bush the tools he needs to fight the war on terrorism and bring the terrorists to justice.”

Pence, a member of the House International Relations Committee, attended President Bush’s speech to Hoosiers this morning in Indianapolis and is available for media interviews.
