

*Nearly \$3.7M In FAA Grants To Aid Construction At County Airport*

**WASHINGTON, DC** - U.S. Congressman Mike Pence announced today that the Department of Transportation's (DOT) Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has awarded the Randolph County Board of Aviation Commissioners two grants totaling \$3,691,659 for construction of a runway at the Randolph County Airport in Winchester, Indiana.
