

U.S. Congressman Mike Pence will be sworn into the 112th Congress on Wednesday, January 5th by House Speaker John Boehner (R-OH). This will be Pence's sixth term in Congress.

"I am grateful once again for the opportunity to serve the people of Indiana in Congress," said Pence. "Our country faces enormous challenges, and I look forward to working with my colleagues to address them by seeking to restore fiscal discipline, promote a strong national defense and defend traditional moral values in our nation's Capital."

The swearing-in will take place tomorrow at noon in the chamber of the U.S. House of Representatives.

Pence will serve on the Judiciary and Foreign Affairs Committees in the 112th Congress.
