

Anderson, IN—U.S. Congressman Mike Pence announced today that the Department of Transportation's Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has awarded the Randolph County Board of Aviation Commissioners a grant in the amount of \$2,189,583 for construction of a runway at the Randolph County Airport in Winchester, Indiana. This is the final phase of the runway construction project.
