

Congressman Will Visit Affected Area on Saturday

Anderson, IN – U.S. Congressman Mike Pence joined the Indiana congressional delegation in supporting Governor Daniels' request for federal disaster assistance to aid the Hoosiers in Southern Indiana affected by last week's tornadoes.

"I support Governor Daniels' request for federal disaster assistance and urge President Obama to act quickly and decisively to augment Indiana's ongoing recovery efforts," said Pence.

Specifically, the governor requested grants for temporary housing and home repairs and other programs to help individuals and business owners recover from the effects of the disaster. The letter requests that a major disaster be declared for Clark, Jefferson, Ripley, Scott, Warrick and Washington Counties. Pence joined members of the Indiana delegation in signing a letter to the President that supported the governor's request.

Saturday, March 10, Rep. Pence will view the tornado damage in Henryville and will visit the relief site at Charlestown.
